

# Plant identification workshops

Landholders and interested community group members in the Broken Hill, White Cliffs and Bourke areas, are invited to attend workshops being held to assist in native plant identification.

The workshops will be presented by Australian Network for Plant Conservation Project Manager, Martin Driver.

Martin has more than 35 years experience in native vegetation management, plant identification, grazing management and restoration ecology.

The workshops will include information about:

- the benefits of retaining native plants on your property
- how to identify native plants
- how to manage native plants to benefit productivity.

The workshops are also an opportunity to exchange information and ideas with other landholders on balancing production and sustainability on your farm.

The workshops will be in the form of 'paddock walks' to allow participants to experience hands-on plant identification in the field.

Participants are required to bring a hat, sunscreen and drinking water. A light lunch will be provided. Landholders are also encouraged to bring along plant samples to be identified.
